Our well is still dropping, last report was 8 mcfpd, and 1 bbl water per day @ 110 psi, going into a 25 psi line. We know some water is going down the line with the gas, but it's hard to separate the water at such low pressures. I told the gauger to shut the well in tomorrow for the weekend and see it builds up any pressure by Monday. Then we will turn the well back to sales.
